

Drumset Patterns

1 Basic Rock 2 3 4

Basic Rock pattern 1-4: A 4/4 drum set pattern consisting of a steady bass drum quarter-note pulse and a snare drum pattern of quarter notes on the 2nd and 4th beats, with 'x' marks above the snare notes indicating cymbal accents.

5 6 7 8

Rock with Snare embellished pattern 5-8: A 4/4 drum set pattern with a steady bass drum quarter-note pulse and a snare drum pattern of quarter notes on the 2nd and 4th beats, with 'x' marks above the snare notes indicating cymbal accents. The snare notes are embellished with eighth-note triplets.

9 10 11 12

13 Basic Swing 14 15 16
